I hope you are well !!! I've been meaning to write you this letter for a while, but know that we'll see each other at Rossi's wedding and will have the opportunity to catch up then.

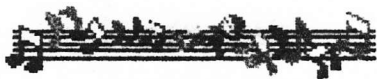
